E-Registration

E-registration should be completed via the links provided on the school website between **18 Dec, 6.00 AM to 20 Dec, 4.00PM.**

E-Registration is **COMPULSORY** for ALL posted students (including DSA students).

You do not need to report to Cedar Girls' until the first day of school on 2nd of January, 2025.

Admission to Cedar is subject to our assessment of the student's suitability and availability of vacancies. All appeals are to be submitted by **24 Dec, 12.00pm**

All appeal requests will be processed by 6 Jan 2025. Only successful applicants will be notified.

Reminders on Student Administration Matters

Purchase of Personal Learning Device (PLD)

- All secondary school students will own a school-prescribed personal learning device (PLD) in 2025
- Students who are Singapore Citizens can use their Edusave Account to pay for the PLD.
- Please do not purchase or use your own purchased device for your daughter / ward.
- More details on Personal Learning Device Programme (PLDP) will be shared later.

School Smart Card Registration to Access Turnstiles

- All Year One(Secondary One) students must bring their primary school EZ-link card between 2nd to 7th Jan 2025 for the School Smart card registration
- A registered Smart Card is needed to access the turnstiles at the side-gates to enter to school.
- Students who walk to school or need to use the turnstiles to enter/exit must register their Smart Card for access.



Reminders on Other Administrative Matters

Car Decal for Parents

- Only parents with car decal registered with the school will be allowed to drive into the school.
- Parents are to register their vehicle number to receive the decal from **3 Jan – 12 Jan 2025**
- The link to apply for the car decal can be found in the school website.

Parental Consent for HPV Vaccination, School-based Health Screening and Dental Service

- The Ministry of Education is providing these services complimentary for all incoming Year One (Secondary One) students.
- Consent for the above services is done online.
- ALL registration for vaccination and dental must be completed by **10 Jan 2025**.

First Day of School

Reporting Procedure on Jan 2nd, 2025

- If you arrive before 7.30AM (6.45AM – 7.30AM), proceed to the school foyer and assemble at school courtyard.
- The Flag-Raising Ceremony will start at 7.40AM in the school courtyard.
- Proceed to check for your class at the noticeboards placed in the school foyer.





First Day Of School

Attire

- Please report in half uniform on the first day of school.

Things to Bring

- Bring a **small bag with writing materials**, and your **water bottle**. You do not need to bring your school books.
- Remember to bring your **primary school EZ-Link Card**.





Road Safety Matters for Parents and Students

Entering the School

Students may enter school through the turnstiles near Cedar Primary, Bidadari Estate and the school's security guard house which will be unlocked on 2 Jan from 7.00am onwards.

Drop-Off and Pick-Up

Your daughter can alight anywhere between the Cedar 65 sign to the back of the General Office wherever it is safe to stop the car. Please allow your daughter to alight as quickly as possible. Also, do not drive on the outer lane of the road near the carpark lots and look out for the directions from our security personnel.

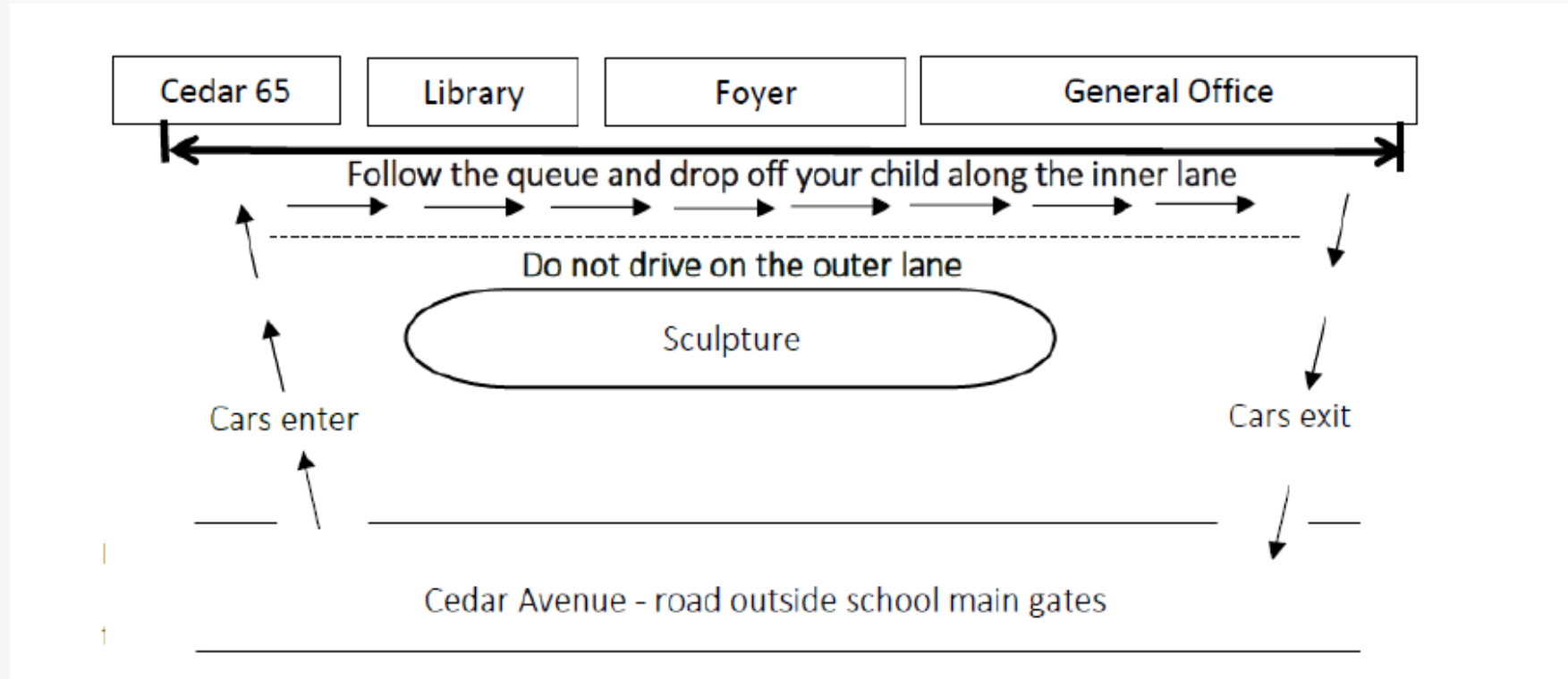
As there is a back gate to the school from the Bidadari estate, there are options to drop your daughter off along Alkaff Crescent or at the multi-storey carpark at Blk 111 A.

For pick-up, if your daughter is not present at the Foyer when you arrive, we would like to request that you drive out of the school and in again to pick her up. At all times, parking and waiting in school is not allowed.

Please note that at all times, parking and waiting in the school is not allowed. Please park at the nearest HDB car park at Joo Seng Road, Block 2A or at Blk 111 A Bidadari, multi-storey car parks.

More Information

- The full school uniform consists of the blouse, skirt, school tie, school badge and name tag.
- The full school uniform is to be worn every Monday post Orientation Week.
- Students can wear the half or full school uniform from Tuesday to Friday.
- For students with PE before recess on Monday, they may wear the half uniform to school to attend flag-raising. Thereafter, they must change into full school uniform by the end of recess.

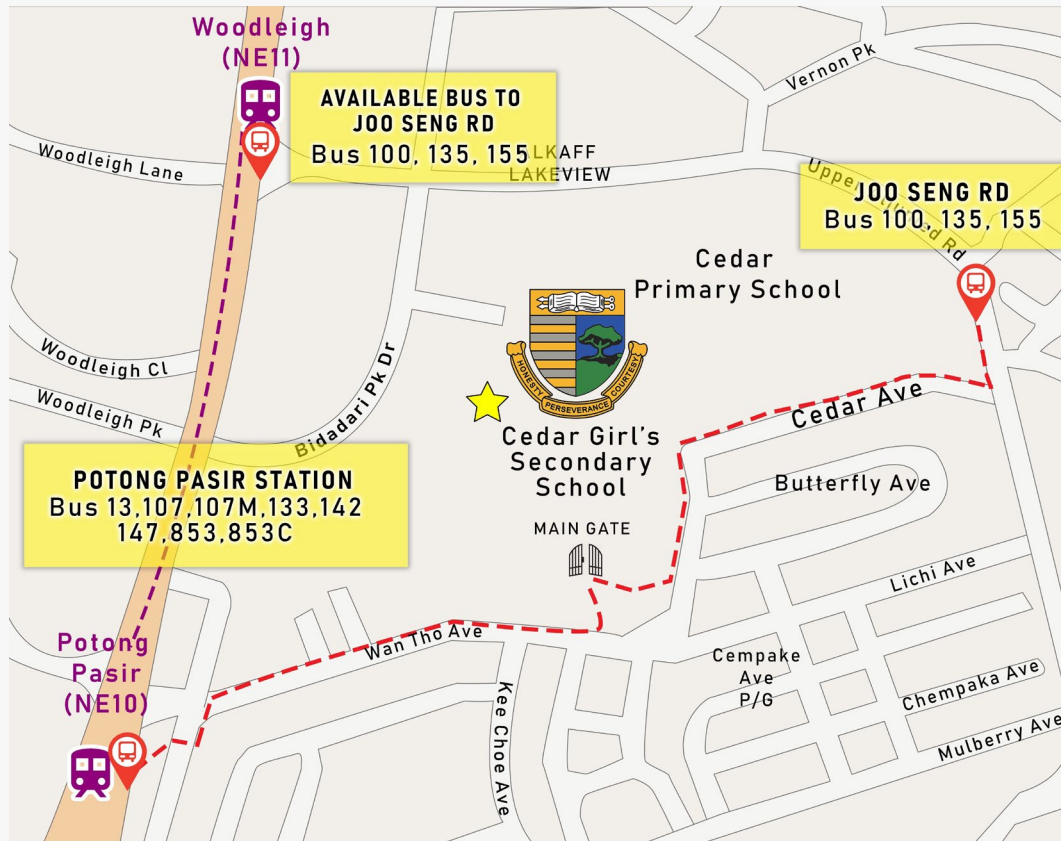
