2026 School Health Programmes for Year 1 & 2 students

HPV Vaccination

 HPB offers fully subsidised Human Papillomavirus (HPV) vaccinations to eligible Secondary 1 and 2 female students. HPV vaccinations are highly recommended for females 9-26 years old for protection against cervical cancer. Parental consent is required before HPV vaccination can be administered.

Dental Screening

- This will be conducted at Cedar Primary School during school hours. Parental consent is required before dental screening can be administered.
- For students who require dental treatments, they will be scheduled to attend at an appointed date and time.

Parental Consent

- Parents and legal guardians can login using Singpass to the HPB Consent Portal to
 - **Opt-In or Opt-Out** for both the **HPV Vaccination and Dental Screening.**
- Please read the questions carefully before you Opt-In (Yes) or Opt-Out (No).
- Your consent must be submitted before the commencement of the HPV Vaccination and Dental Screening sessions are conducted.

Health Screening

- Health screening is compulsory for all students. If parents and legal guardians wish to Opt-Out, they
 must write an email to HPB at contact YPS@hpb.gov.sg
- Year 2 students who are identified to attend CVDRF (Cardiovascular Disease Risk Factor) screening will be informed when they attend their health screening. CVDRF Blood test will be conducted on the last day of the Health Screening Programme.
